He has also pioneered two innovative psycho-socio-spiritual interventions for Asian Palliative Care including Mindful-Compassion Art Therapy (MCAT) and Family Dignity Intervention (FDI). Based on this body of work authored over 50 books, chapters and articles in prominent journals, as well as presented in over 100 keynotes, invited and conference presentations around the world.
