

Visit to RCHE on End-of-Life Care Choices for Caring and Dying in Place

Caring and dying in place can enhance the quality of life for patients and families at end-of-life. This post-conference visit is tailored for professionals dedicated to understanding different End-of-Life Care (EoLC) choices for caring and dying in place beyond the hospital setting. Experts from a state-of-the-art local hospice home and residential care homes for elderly (RCHEs) will share their experience on supporting patients and families to be cared at community settings outside hospital. Participants will also be given the opportunity to visit the Society for the Promotion of Hospice Care (SPHC) Jockey Club Home for Hospice (JCHH), and RCHEs providing EoLC in Hong Kong, learning about their innovative services and excellent facilities.
