

## **Professional Seminar on Good Quality of End-of-Life Care through A Team Approach**

In 2015, the Lien Foundation in Singapore extended their research into the Quality of Death Index to 80 countries around the world. The Quality of Death Index has implications on the care and support offered to end-of-life patients and family caregivers in the clinical setting. This seminar is tailored for health and social care professionals, with the aim to discuss what constitutes good quality of end-of-life care, in the context of a team approach. The case of Taiwanese celebrity Mr Fu Ta-Jen seeking euthanasia in Switzerland will be discussed to illustrate the conditions required for high quality end-of-life care through a team approach.
