Ms Chee Wai Yee is a member of Singapore's National ACP Steering Committee and serves as the Community Lead. She chaired the first ACP Week organized in 2019, bringing health and social care partners on board to raise awareness of ACP among healthcare workers and members of the public.

As Senior Director of Montfort Care, she pilots Grief Matter – a community movement promoting advance care conversations, grief literacy and death education, in addition to supporting bereaved families and people dying in the community. Since 2018, she has trained more than 150 employees in Montfort Care across its different Centres in Singapore to promote an ACP-informed approach in community work with the seniors. Montfort Care remains the only community social agency with ACP facilitation skills included as core training for all client-facing staff. Wai Yee also serves as a Programme Director with the Singapore Hospice Council, to promote psychosocial care, including grief and bereavement care, among palliative care providers. She is registered as a Professional Deputy/Donee with the Office of the Public Guardian, to provide an alternative for individuals, in particular elderly singles or childless elderly couples who may not have a suitable family member or friend to be their proxy decision-makers.
