She is recognized nationally for her leadership in developing the field of clinical Geropsychology, for which she has received multiple awards. She has published widely on mental health and aging, caregiver interventions, and Geropsychology, including books such as Caregiver Family Therapy and Aging and Mental Health. At UCCS, she co-founded the training clinic and doctoral program in clinical psychology that focuses on Geropsychology. She has built inter-disciplinary innovation centers to foster research and education in senior housing and outpatient health and wellness facilities. She enjoys translating research and best practice concepts to a broad set of audiences, including community members, direct care staff, administrators and planners as well as professionals and policy leaders.
