Maureen P. Keeley (Ph.D., University of Iowa, 1994), is a Professor at Texas State University in San Marcos, Texas, USA. She conducts research and teaches communication classes focused on Interpersonal, Family, Nonverbal, Relational, End-of-Life Communication, and Relational Health. For over two decades, her program of research has focused on communication at the End-of-Life (EOL) encouraging and improving communication between family members and their loved ones who are terminally ill. She is considered the preeminent expert on “final conversations” and is at the forefront of EOL family communication research in the United States of America. Her published scholarship includes: 1 book*, 1 edited journal issue on EOL Family Communication for Behavioral Science, and 50 publications in International/National academic journals and/or edited books. *Her co-authored book with Dr. Julie Yingling titled “Final Conversations: Helping the Living and the Dying Talk to Each Other” (2007) won 3 National Awards. They are currently working on an updated edition of this book with 6 new chapters highlighting new findings that Dr. Keeley has discovered in the past 15 years.
