

## **Visionary Actualiser Workshop: Steps and Tips on Planning End-of-Life Care Services in the Community**

In this workshop, the speaker will summarise his experience in end-of-life care and bereavement service projects being implemented in the past decade, and share his experiences in actualising death-related services in the social service sector, ranging from carrying out life and death educational talks or training, soliciting funding support, to building up a medical-social service model, as well as putting holistic end-of-life care services into practice in the community. Instead of thinking the issue as merely about making a service proposal, actualising an end-of-life care or related service project is something more on a comprehensive and detailed thinking process about our service users, manpower and staff, collaborative partners and available resources in the community. Some key consideration points of this thinking process will be summarised for participants' reference.
