The Centre offers professional and innovative music therapy services and training. In 2017, IMTC becomes Hong Kong's first social enterprise dedicating to the development and promotion of music therapy both locally and globally. Mr. Chung has worked with many populations from various walks of life, including stroke patients, cancer patients, SEN children, mental patients, substance abusers and more. Organisations that he had worked with include Hong Kong Red Cross John F. Kennedy Centre, The Hong Kong Society for Rehabilitation, Tung Wah Group of Hospitals, Maggie's Cancer Caring Centre, The Society for the Aid and Rehabilitation of Drug Abusers, New Life Psychiatric Rehabilitation Association and more. Besides social organisations and schools, he also collaborated with corporates like HSBC. Hang Seng Bank, OSIM, Parson's Music to hold Music Therapy talks and training workshops. He had been interviewed by local press such as SCMP, Mingpao, AM730, Oriental Daily, HK01, TVB, RTHK, I-Cable and was nominated for the Spirit of Hong Kong Awards in 2019.
